To be allowed to submit a bid, Bidder's must have the minimum experience set forth in the Bidder's Qualifications. Contractors: To be allowed to submit a bid, Bidders (Contractors) and Bidder's Superintendent must have the minimum experience requirements, and Bidder must certify that they do not have certain health and safety violations as described below. To allow the University to evaluate Bidders, each Bidder must submit qualification documents consisting of an experience record and other required documents at the place and time stipulated in this Advertisement for Bids. The experience record must be described in the Bidder's Qualifications form found in the Bidding Documents as Exhibit 13. To be allowed to submit a bid, the Bidder must demonstrate ALL of the following in the Contractor's Statement of Experience and Claims History:

Submit one (1) comparable project for the proposed Bidder. A "comparable project" is defined as having ALL of the following:

- 1. Construction was performed in the State of California under California Building Codes.
- 2. Construction cost at the bid date was \$100,000
- 3. Experience working in an occupied acute general care hospital, or a comparable facility.
- 4. 75% Completed within five (5) years of the date of this submittal.
- 5. Office located within 50 miles of project.
