DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

UCSF is installing a new compact 7T GE magnet at Byers Hall, Room 110A, in Mission Bay. The old MRI equipment has been removed by others. The project scope includes the required infrastructure and utility modifications of existing rooms 110A and 112 to install and house the new MRI and its peripheral equipment, and any necessary coordination/work required with the equipment vendor and UCSF facilities to pass the site readiness checklist for a complete installation and setup. See project drawings for detailed scope.

Contractor shall provide all necessary work, including but not limited to labor, materials, equipment, tools, transportation, insurance, and services, to complete the project and obtain its final approval (i.e. certificate of occupancy, final job card sign-off job card or equivalent) from the applicable Authority Having Jurisdiction(s). Project final job card sign-off (or equivalent) from AHJ's will require the completion of MRI installation, commission, and set-up, in addition to the scope of work performed by the Contractor. Contractor shall diligently work with UCSF, Architect & Engineer, and the equipment vendor to obtain the final job card sign-off (or equivalent) within the specified Contract Time.

(After conclusion of the Pre-Bid Conference, the Pre-Bid Job Walk will be conducted at Byers Hall, MRI Room 110/112, beginning at 11:00AM.) Only bidders who participate in both the Conference and the Job Walk in their entirety will be allowed to bid on the Project as prime contractors. Bids are to be submitted to The Regents of the University of California ("University") using BuildingConnected as this is an electronically sealed bid project. Bids must be submitted at or before March 5, 2026, 2:00PM for furnishing all labor, materials, services, and equipment to complete the Work described below in accordance with the enclosed Bidding Documents.
