The University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) Health is seeking an Inspector to help build the UCSF Health Central Laboratory and Pharmacy TI at 369 Oyster Point Blvd, South San Francisco, CA. Refer to the RFQ Scope document for trade description of work.

UCSF Health is planning a new 7-story facility to centralize and modernize pharmacy and laboratory services. The project will consolidate currently distributed functions to improve efficiency, expand capacity, and support system-wide growth, while enhancing patient care and diagnostic performance.

Program:

- Central Lab Center (Approx. 140,000 DGSF): Located on Levels 2–5 for centralized diagnostic, pathology, and genomics services.
- Central Pharmacy Services Center (Approx. 50,000 DGSF): Located on Levels 6–7, with partial Level 6 as future shell space; includes specialty and hospital pharmacy, automation, and expanded distribution and infusion services.
- Ground Level (Level 1): Loading dock, pharmacy warehousing, and lab gas/chemical storage.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each responding firm may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy.
