Firms must submit for the full scope including the new tower which is further defined in the HDH scope.

UCSF Health's patient census is at record highs, and it needs to expand to accommodate projections for increasing patient demand. UCSF Health is seeking a Smoke Control Special Inspection and Testing Services firm to assist in the design, construction, and commissioning of the UCSF Health Helen Diller Hospital (HDH), a state-of-the-art new hospital that will create an optimal healing environment addressing social, psychological, spiritual, and behavioral components of health in one place.
