Upgrade the building controls to tie into BMS.

The scope of the project is to provide new building management system to replace existing system for UCSF Rutter Garage and Community Center. Provide new ethernet switch and new cable. New Cable cat 6A will be provide from each ethernet to each HVAC device.

Contractor should document all set points, before work begins to verify new controllers have the correct set point, balance set point, static, temperature etc.

Only bidders who participate in both the Conference and the Job Walk in their entirety will be allowed to bid on the Project as prime contractors. Sealed Bids for Lump Sum will not be accepted after 2:00 PM, April 18, 2024.

Bids will be opened after 2:05 PM, April 18, 2024.

Prior to the Bid Deadline and after bid opening, the University may establish a new Bid Deadline no earlier than 24 hours from the prior Bid Deadline, if no material changes are made to the bidding documents, and no earlier than 72 hours if material changes are made. In such event the University will, at a minimum, notify all persons or entities known by the University to have received a complete set of Bidding

Documents and who has provided a street address and/or facsimile number for receipt of any written pre-bid communications.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage at the location of the work.

In addition, the University is committed to promoting and increasing participation of small business enterprises (SBEs) and disabled veteran business enterprises (DVBES) relating to all goods and services covered under the awarded agreement, subject to any and all applicable obligations under state and federal law, and University policies.
