#### **DESCRIPTION OF WORK:**

The project is to replace the building existing DI water (Distilled Water) system plastic piping with new stainless-steel piping, replace existing DI water storage tank level switches with new level transmitters at Health Sciences West (HSW) first floor plant space, and to replace five existing DI water transfer pumps with new stainless steel transfer pumps.
