### Program Overview and Goals

The UCSF Sheltered Bidding Program (SBP) will designate a portion of contracts to Small Business Enterprises (SBE) and/or Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE).

Projects: Negotiated and Informal Form

- Construction less than \$640,000 Sheltered Bidding
- Professional or Consulting less than \$100,000 –
   Applicant Pool

#### Goals

- Increase SBE/DVBE participation of 25% by 2025
- Provide greater opportunities for SBE/DVBE in UC Capital Programs
- Build the capacity of small firms
